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**Councilman Howe moved to amend the agenda by changing Item 3 from a Discussion Item to an Action Item. 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**ACTION ITEM: Consider a Noise Ordinance - Continued**

Councilman Stone introduced updated definitions and enforcement guidelines to the Noise Ordinance Draft, clarifying terminology and outlining measurable standards for sound levels.

Councilwoman Harrison recommended collaborating with Chief Fullmer to determine reasonable fine amounts for noise violation citations. She also requested that copies of the revised draft be distributed to council members for review prior to the next City Council Meeting, noting that the Council should be fully prepared before advancing the ordinance to a public hearing.

Councilman Stone will send a copy to Ms. Keller to distribute to the rest of the Council for review. Noise Ordinance will continue the next City Council Meeting on August 7<sup>th</sup>, 2025.
